LATE COMING (GRADE 1 - 4)

Late coming has become a huge problem. Not only is it extremely disruptive for the class but it causes unnecessary stress for the child entering the class late. School for Grade 1 - 4 starts at 08h00 **promptly** with the children lining up when the bell rings.

EARLY CARE

Please note that children from Discovery Class to Gr R **may not** be left unattended before 08h00 in the morning. Parents must accompany their child until such time as the teacher arrives at the classroom. Children attending earlycare must be signed in by their **parents/guardians only**. If you are not able to stay with your child, please book them in to the earlycare. The cost thereof is R25.00 per day and can be used in an ad hoc capacity.

SCHOOL UNIFORMS

You will recall that at the end of last term we mentioned that as part of the re-branding of King's, we embarked upon a journey of introducing a new uniform. The manufacturers are busy and we hope to show you the new look and feel of the uniform shortly.

The roll out of the new uniform will take place over a period of 24 months. Our 2016 intake will have the opportunity to start their school career off with the new King's School uniform. The uniform will be worn from Gr R onwards.

CONCERT 2015

The annual school concert is always a highlight of the year. It is a wonderful opportunity for parents, grandparents to enjoy the children as they give expression to their stage talent. The concert '**YOU ARE SPECIAL**' takes place on 19 September 2015. The children will need to be at school by 10h00 with the concert starting at 11h00.



Tickets will be on sale from 7 September 2015 at R40.00 per adult and R20.00 per child. Children taking part in the concert do not pay. Tickets will not be sold on the day.

A DVD will be taken of the concert by SGM Productions and can be ordered via the office. The cost thereof will be R130.00.

2016 PLACEMENT FEE
