In light of this being a long term, the School Board together with the WCED have given permission for the school to utilize two days for school holidays. UNIFORMS

As you are aware, the new uniforms can be ordered from the school. **Winter uniform must be worn from 3 May 2016.**

Please note the following in this regard:

- We aim to phase in the new uniform over a period of 18-24 months. This is to ensure that folk who bought new uniforms in 2015, still have a fair amount of wear out of it.
- The school uniform, i.e. the track suit, white T-shirt and school shorts/ skorts are to be worn by all from **Gr 1 onwards**.
- The Gr R's are to wear a white T-shirt, blue shorts, white socks and white takkies. They are required to wear the school tracksuit as part of the winter uniform. They are not required to wear the school T-shirts or shorts/ skorts. They may wear a navy jersey over their white T's, under the track top, if the weather is very cold. For winter, they may wear long-sleeved white T shirts.
- The incentive/ discount scheme, is only applicable for 2016. So, new uniforms ordered and paid for in 2017 will not be available at the discount structure we've put together for 2016.
- We ask that parents take the time to size their own children. This is so that you take full responsibility for the order you place. The school will not be held liable for incorrect orders placed by parents.
- The Gr RR's (Pre Reception) are not required to wear any uniform.
- **The secretary will be available to assist with the sizing as well as take your orders between 08h00 – 09h00 Monday to Friday. 13h30 – 15h00, every afternoon EXCEPT TUESDAY and FRIDAY afternoon.**

Please note the following important information.



- Fees are paid monthly in advance (by 1st of each month) for 12 months.
- We are changing to a 10/11 month payment structure in 2017.
- Our preferred method of payment is by Debit Order.
- Debit Orders returned will incur a levy of R 150.00.

When exiting the school or any of the options i.e. earlycare / aftercare, a 3 Month Notice Period Form must be completed. This form is available from the office.
