### **END OF TERM PROCEDURES**

The formal, final exams for Gr 4 & 5 will start on the **18 November** and end on the **25 November**. School will dismiss at **1:00 pm** from 18 November until the 6 December 2016 for the Grade 3 – 5 pupils. Please make the necessary arrangements with transport companies.

We request that parents assist their child/ren by ensuring that they come to school regularly. This is a short term with much to be done. Staying absent will only be detrimental to their success.

The **GR R GRADUATION CEREMONY** will take place on the **6 December 2016 at 10:30am**. This is a very important occasion for the little ones. They are saying goodbye to pre-school and entering the world of 'big' school. Gr 1 is a much more formal teaching and learning environment. We would like to make this a very special occasion for the children and their parents.

Tuesday, 6 December will be last day of formal school for the Gr R's. Aunty Shelley will be here on 7<sup>th</sup> December and After School Care is also available for those who need it. However, for those children who have supervision at home, they do not have to come to school after the Graduation.

The **Final Assembly will be held on 7 December**. Starting at 9:30 am. Gr R will not be part of this occasion. They will have their graduation ceremony on 6 December, as mentioned above.

At the final assembly the children will be receiving their award certificates for academic achievements as well as certificates to acknowledge certain character qualities which the teachers have seen and wish to endorse in the lives. They will also receive their final reports on this day.



### 2017 EARLY CARE / AFTER SCHOOL / HOLIDAY CARE

**Application** must be made should you wish your child to attend Early care / Aftercare School Care in **2017**. Forms available at the office.

#### ACCOUNTS

Every family will receive a new **2017 Bank Debit Order Instruction Form** which must please be completed and returned urgently for processing. Should you be paying Fees annually – the form must still be completed with the words **ANNUAL PAYMENT** written over the bank detail section but the option section completed and signed.

Please take note: **AD HOC FEES** are **NOT** included in the Bank Debit Order Instruction Form. These are billed monthly and need to be paid directly into the school's bank account.

School fees are paid over 12 months – January – December. The final payment for 2016 is due on the **1<sup>st</sup> of December 2016**.

To qualify for the **10% discount** on 2017 annual fees, payment of the fee must be made by the **1<sup>st</sup> December 2016**. Annual payments made by the **1 January 2017**, qualify for **7% discount**.

Please ensure that the office has received the official Notice Period Form should your child not be returning to King's for 2017. If notice is not received timeously, you will be liable for fees next year.
