### **WOOLWORTHS MY SCHOOL CARD**

King's School partners with WOOLWORTH'S and it's MY SCHOOL program. We encourage parents to acquire the MY SCHOOL card and to link it to KING'S SCHOOL. It is a very easy, passive, non-invasive form of fund raising for the school.

### **ACCOUNTS**

Please visit our website for the 2018 School fee structure:

Some important changes to take note of regarding 2018 Fee Structure:

- **SCHOOL FEES** are now payable over an **11 period**. This was tabled at the 2016 AGM.
- **SCHOOL FEES** are now inclusive of additional costs such as screening fees, book fees, camp fees for Gr 6 and Conquesta. It excludes uniforms and text books for Gr 4 -7.
- **ANNUAL PAYMENT DISCOUNT:** This is only applicable to school fees and does not include ADHOC or fees payable to external service providers such as SOCCER STARZ, etc.
  - Annual Fee (2018 fees) paid by the 1 December 2017 will be discounted by 10%
  - Annual Fee (2018 fees) paid between 2 December 2017 and 2 January 2018 will be discounted by 7%.
  - **SIBLING DISCOUNT:**    2<sup>nd</sup> child 6%    3<sup>rd</sup> child 3%

## DEBIT ORDERS

**Debit orders are fixed monthly amounts which comprise of school fees and after school care/early care ONLY.**

Returned debit orders do not automatically get deducted again i.e. double deducted. Arrear amounts must be paid via EFT or Speed point. Debit orders will be reloaded for the following month. Should the debit order not go through for a second time – a new debit order form will need to be completed.

ADHOC costs are a separate entity which can change on a monthly basis depending on the number of hours utilized. ADHOC can only be paid either via EFT or Speed point.

EFT PAYMENTS: When making an EFT payment, please utilize your family's unique reference number together with what the payment is for in abbreviated form e.g. Aftercare would be (AC) Ad hoc (ADH), etc.

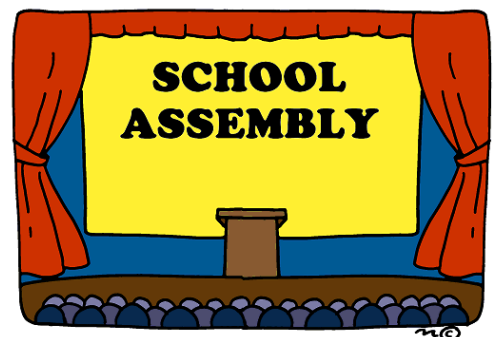
## END OF TERM PROCEDURES

Although there are no formal exams at the end of the 3<sup>rd</sup> term, the reports will reflect the continuous assessment marks for each subject. i.e. the assignments, projects and class tests done during the term make up the 3<sup>rd</sup> term report mark.
