As mentioned, our School Uniform is only available via the school. We do not hold stock and items need to be pre-ordered and paid for. Orders can take up to 8 – 10 weeks before delivery therefore it

is imperative to place your order timeously.

Orders can be placed at any time during the year however, the supplier cannot manufacture just one item at a time. Once they receive a reasonable number of orders, production takes place. It is very important to place your winter uniform order before the middle of February / beginning of March. Please note payment must accompany the order.
